

I authorize Bank to disclose the following data:

Name, address, date of birth, email address, telephone number, amount of the debt, the period of time the payment is overdue, repayment modalities, steps taken by the credit institution in connection with the payment due date and legal proceedings as well as the misuse

being reported to the respective local credit reference agency:

Schufa (Germany), Centrale Rischi (Italy), Biuro Informacij Kredytowej (Poland) or Biroul de Credit (Romania),

within the scope of the existing business relationship and also after the termination of the business relationship until complete settlement due to conduct contrary to the contract set by me for the purpose of creditor protection and risk minimization, from which the participating credit institutions can obtain warnings of customer behavior in breach of contract.

I am aware that my consent may be withdrawn at any time and acknowledge that a revocation of consent will not affect the lawfulness of any disclosure of Data carried out before consent is withdrawn.

Bank may disclose all current and historical data related to my past and/or present account(s), including, but not limited to, the existence of the account in my name, my identity, address and taxpayer identification number (TIN), the beneficial owner of the account, the holders of powers of attorney for the account, the details of any account transactions, the nature, balances and compositions of the assets held in the account and any correspondence related to the account and/or the FATCA Forms and such other information, outside of Europe and Western Union, to the Internal Revenue Service, the DOJ or any other US governmental authority and to other governments pursuant to a similar body of laws, including the OECD Common Reporting Standard as enacted into local law which is necessary in order to fulfill your obligations under the Tax information Authority Law (as amended), Regulations and Guidance Notes made pursuant to that Law and relevant intergovernmental agreements in relation to the automatic exchange of information for tax matters (collectively "FATCA").
